REGISTRATION AND LOCATION OF SESSIONS

- Registration and Lunch/Coffee Breaks
 - The registration desk for the event will be located in the <u>upper foyer</u> of the Aston University Main Building (enter the main building and take the stairs opposite reception). The registration desk will open at 08:30 AM on the 5^{th of} April for delegates.
 - Coffee/Refreshment Breaks will be held in **G63** (the cloakroom/refreshment area) on the same floor as the upper foyer, in the Main Building.
 - During the Lunch Break, lunch will be served at the Courtyard Restaurant on the ground floor of Conference Aston.
 - Lunch times: 12:00– 1:00 PM on the 5th and 6th April.
- There will also be a Welcome Reception from **6pm-7:30pm** on the 4th April, in the Conference Aston Lounge in Conference Aston/Aston Business School.

Conference Dinner:

This year's Conference/Gala Dinner will be held at the **Birmingham Council House**, **Banqueting Suite**.

The address for the Birmingham Council House is:

The Council House is approximately a 20-minute walk from Aston University – delegates will be required to make their own way to the venue, but there **will be a group leaving from the Conference Aston Reception at 6:45 pm** if delegates would like to join them.

The **Drinks Reception** will start at **7 pm**, with **dinner** being served at **8 pm**. You will be required to show your <u>**Dinner Ticket**</u> upon arrival at the Council House, so please ensure you keep it with you!

If you specified a dietary when you registered, then **you will need to pick up a dietary tent card** when you arrive at the Banqueting Suite, to put on your table for the waiters.

The dress code for the evening will be **<u>smart casual/formal.</u>**

There will be a paid bar available at the venue and the entertainment will be performed by the Neil McCracken Trio from the Birmingham Conservatoire.

PARKING

There is limited parking available on and near campus. Please check and book one of the following parking options if you are planning to arrive by car:

<u>Please note</u> there is no parking available at the Council House.

- <u>Conference Aston First Park</u>. Rate: fixed **£7.95 for 24 hours**. Location: Car park 12 (See University Campus Map attached).
- <u>Car park 5</u> (See University Campus Map attached). Rate: £6 per visit (6 AM 10 PM).
- <u>Car park 6</u> Rate: (From 16:30 to 23:30) **£1 for 2 hours, £4 for 4 hours, £5 for 6,5** hours.
- <u>Millennium Point</u>. Rate: hourly basis approx. **£5.90 for a 6-hour visit**. Location: Check the attached Campus Map.

WIFI AND INTERNET CONNECTION
